### Good Sex: What (Almost) Nobody Will Tell You About Sex

God designed sex as a good thing ... within the bonds of marriage, of course! This is the message that MAYCOG leaders delivered to about 40 youth over three Saturdays in October. MAYCOG's "Good Sex: What (Almost) Nobody Will Tell You About Sex" was a purity program that presented a whole person approach to teenage sexuality. It was a huge success!

The seven-session program addressed the following topics: sex messaging, sexual identity, intimacy, desire, boundaries, responsibility, and do-overs. They reviewed Bible passages to hear what God has to say about each of these topics and to learn how Bible characters dealt with these tough subjects. At each session, the youth engaged in thoughtful discussions about deep issues, such as the difference between true intimacy and sex, the consequences of lust, and God's offering of forgiveness.

At the first session, the youth were graced with a special treat. Dr. Wesley McNeese shared with the youth his expertise about sexually transmitted infections and diseases. He also shared his pastoral heart and desire that people trust God's promise for good sex in marriage. The youth asked so many questions that every time Dr. McNeese prepared to sit down, he had to stand up again.

On the last Saturday of the program, the youth were presented certificates celebrating their participation in the purity program. On Friday, October 29, 2010, the participants came together again to Celebrate with a hayride and bonfire in West Alton, MO. The "Good Sex" program was a success indeed!
